RECOMMENDED IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE FOR PERSONS

AGE 7-18

AGE

9 Years

IMMUNIZATION

Human Papillomavirus (for Cervical Cancer Prevention) for females. Second dose 2 months after the first dose and the third dose 6 months after the first dose. **RECOMMENDED FOR FEMALES 9-26 YEARS IN AGE.**

11 Years

Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (after this immunization, Tetanus Diphtheria immunizations are recommended every 10 years or if a dirty wound occurs, every 5 years).

Meningococcal

If a person has not been immunized for any of the childhood vaccines, they can be completed at this time. These may include: Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Polio, Varicella (Chicken Pox), Pneumococcal (for high risk groups such as sickle cell disease, functional or anatomic asplenia, HIV infection, Alaska native, African American, American Indian, child care attendance, Cochlear implant and those suffering from chronic illness).

INFLUENZA VACCINE IS GIVEN ON A YEARLY BASIS.
