The Cherokee County Suicide Prevention Coalition Scholarship (\$500) will be awarded to help a qualified student enter a health care, social work, or a public service occupation.

Applications are due on April 1, 2026. Applications will be screened by the coalition's Scholarship Committee.

The Suicide Coalition will review the recommendations of the scholarship committee at the April meeting.

The scholarship will be awarded in the month of May 2026 by a Suicide Coalition designee.

Eligibility Criteria for the scholarship:

- A resident of Cherokee County.
- A high school senior in good standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Entering a health care, social work, or a public service occupation.
- Preference given to those affected by suicide.
